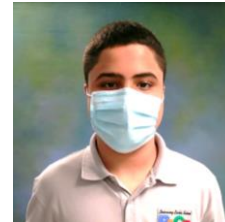

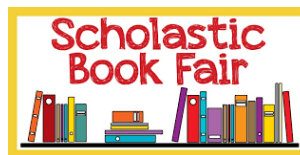
Bring on the School Spirit
