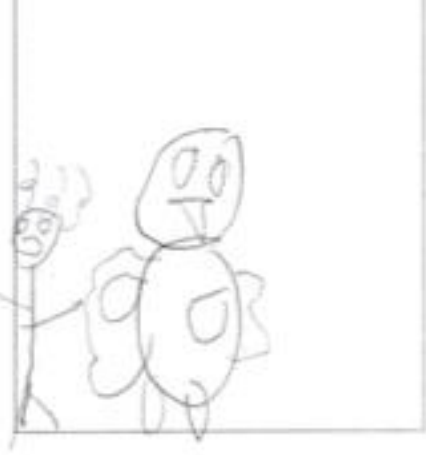
The Super Duper Turkey

The turkey kept chasing the villain away.

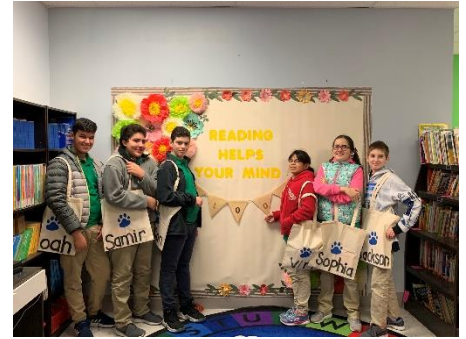

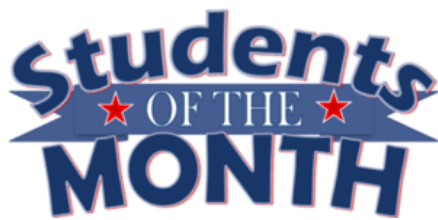
